

**Parkview Christian School
Board Minutes / 12-14-2009 / 6:30 p.m.**

The School Board of Parkview Christian Schools, Inc., conducted its monthly meeting on Mon., November 14, 2009 at Calvary Church. Members present were Mr. Jim Ballard, Mr. Alan Branding, Mr. Todd Case, Mr. Steve Davenport, Mr. Vince Henzel, and Mr. Mike Mertens. Those absent were Mr. Ben Kramer.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Zach Kassebaum gave a Superintendent's report during Executive Session that included reports on Pre-School & Daycare, the Elementary and Secondary, Athletics, and Development.

Discussion items included the school's relationship with the church, and the upcoming Founder's Dinner.

OPEN MEETING

Meeting was called to order by Jim Ballard at 7:23 p.m. Prayer and the devotion were offered by Mr. Jim Ballard.

Board Minutes

A motion was made by Alan Branding to accept the minutes from the Oct. 12, 2009 meeting. Steve Davenport seconded and voting was all in favor.

Mike Mertens made a motion to accept the minutes from the Nov. 9, 2009 meeting. Steve Davenport seconded and voting was unanimous.

Action Items –Mr. Kassebaum announced the school will host a Founders Dinner on Feb. 28, 2010 at the Nebraska Club in downtown Lincoln. A tentative outline has been established and more details will follow. Kassebaum said he wants PCS to maintain and publicly announce its commitment to excellence and continue to move in that direction.

Kassebaum also stated a dinner for the teachers is being planned and sponsored by the Parent Teacher Association (P.T.A.) to be held in the Royal Room. Board Members are encouraged to help in the set up and clean-up. Discussion followed amongst Board members to be supportive as possible to the P.T.A.

PCS Report/Updates

Written reports were provided for the Growing Hearts Daycare/Pre-School, Elementary School, Guidance Report, and Development. Mr. Kassebaum also gave several brief oral updates regarding the current status of the school, which included the following items:

- three packets to prospective families had been mailed out in November;
- since prayer began to acquire 15 new students, PCS has been rewarded with nine so far. Praise God and keeping praying!
- Parkview has a total enrollment of 175 students – up from the 171 mark at the same time last year;
- the possibility exists of securing six international students for the second semester;
- The elementary Christmas program was held Dec. 4 and the middle school and high school program will take place on Dec. 18.

- The Bike-A-Thon is ahead \$500 over 2008, with a total received of \$18,417.97.

Public Forum – nothing discussed

Mike Mertens made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Steve Davenport seconded.
